# Virginia S. Boyce Humanitarian Award



The Education and Research Foundation is pleased to announce the 2015 recipient of the Virginia S. Boyce Humanitarian Award: Beth Colon, Certified Ophthalmic Technician (COT). The Virginia S. Boyce Humanitarian Award was established in 2000 in honor of Virginia Boyce, CEO of Prevent Blindness from 1972 to 1982, who gave eighteen combined years of devoted volunteer service to JCAHPO and the Foundation.

She has worked hard to support eye care technicians locally and also served with enthusiasm in Latin America. Ophthalmic Personnel Society. Beth has participated in eight mission trips to El Salvador to provide eye care to villagers in remote areas. She also spent a month in Guatemala working with a local orphanage.
