

This course will describe the essentials of the neuro-ophthalmic exam. It will focus on key skills including how to perform a detailed pupillary exam, confrontational visual fields, color vision testing,

extraocular motility, and alignment.

This course will cover plus cylinder retinoscopy and refractometry. The optics behind the principles of plus cylinder retinoscopy will be included, followed by graphical examples of the procedures. The course will move to the refinement part of the process, showing methods utilizing the Jackson cross cylinder. The course concludes with completing the refractometry procedure with reading add,

balancing techniques, and the duochrome test.

Microinvasive glaucoma surgery (MIGS) is changing the way we treat our patients with glaucoma. We are entering an era where early surgical management may be preferred over medical therapy if these procedures prove to be both safe and effective. Several devices are already approved by the FDA and

there are many more in the pipeline that will be widely available soon.

1:50-2:40 p.m. CORNEAL ENDOTHELIAL KERATOPLASTY (PENETRATING KERATOPLASTY, DSAEK AND DMEK)

The course will cover preoperative considerations such as clinical evaluation and investigations relevant to DSAEK and DMEK. It will discuss preoperative counselling and surgical planning, surgical management in different case scenarios with step-by-step video-based discussion and modifications,

and postoperative considerations such as treatment regimen and management.

2:40-3:30 p.m. **A TO Z IN OPHTHALMOLOGY**

Craig Simms, BSc, COMT, ROUB, CDOS

This lecture will start at A and end at Z, giving an example of an eye condition or disease for each letter of the alphabet. Photos, ultrasound, electrophysiology, IVFA, and video images of ocular conditions will be used to illustrate the pathology from a diagnostic imaging perspective. A short discussion on conditions will be offered to help the participants recognize the different conditions

while performing ophthalmic testing in their own clinic.
