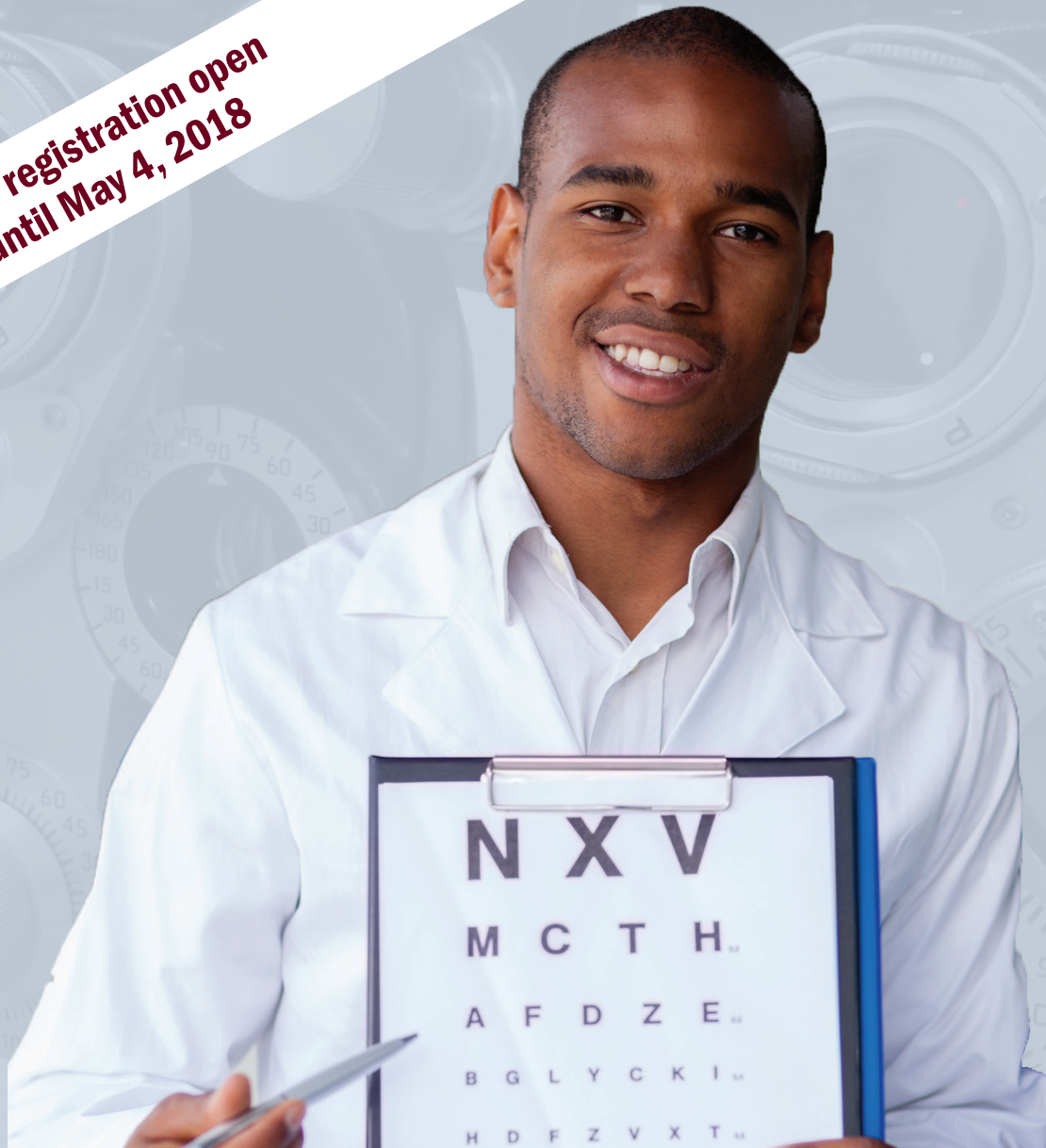

Pediatric oculoplastic surgery encompasses eyelid, lacrimal, and orbital disease in children. This lecture covers common problems including congenital ptosis, nasolacrimal duct obstruction, and capillary hemangiomas, as well as uncommon problems including genetic syndromes and malignant tumors.

A RAPD is one of the most objective signs in ophthalmology and requires investigation as to the cause. RAPD may come in large and small varieties, and often small RAPDs are not recognized which could lead to poor patient outcomes. This course will go from a basic to more advanced understanding of this sign and how to measure it.
