



8:00-9:00 a.m.	PEDIATRIC OCULOPLASTIC SURGERY <i>Richard C. Allen, MD, PhD, FACS</i> Pediatric oculoplastic surgery encompasses eyelid, lacrimal, and orbital disease in children. This lecture covers common problems including congenital ptosis, nasolacrimal duct obstruction, and capillary hemangiomas, as well as uncommon problems including genetic syndromes and malignant tumors.
9:00-10:00 a.m.	RAPD – HOW TO DO IT AND WHAT IT MEANS Jade Schiffman, MD, FAAO, FAAN A RAPD is one of the most objective signs in ophthalmology and requires investigation as to the cause. RAPD may come in large and small varieties, and often small RAPDs are not recognized which could lead to poor patient outcomes. This course will go from a basic to more advanced understanding of this sign and how to measure it.

10:15-11:15 a.m.	UNDER THE KNIFE: BEHIND THE SCENES OF DIFFICULT CASES <i>Frank Scribbick, MD</i> This course will present difficult general surgical cases and their management. Important steps in the diagnosis, pre-op and patient management that lead to positive outcomes will be discussed. Complicated procedures and post-op care of various difficult cases and how the technician can recognize and assist in these critical moments will be addressed.
11:15 a.m12:15 p.m.	MEDICOLEGAL ISSUES OF THE ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD <i>Michelle Pineda, MBA</i> This course will discuss electronic healthcare record challenges and provide examples of where documentation can go wrong. Using actual claims and lawsuits, the instructor will present examples of the pitfalls relating to the use of EHRs and provide recommendations on how to better utilize your system to reduce the risk of patient harm.

1:00-2:00 p.m.	CORNEAL CROSS-LINKING Vasudha Panday, MD This lecture will discuss the scientific value of corneal cross-linking treatment of keratoconus eye disease. It will describe how these corneal anchors prevent the cornea from bulging and becoming steep and irregular. A history of keratoconus, previous treatment, and surgical options, diagnostic testing and CXL procedure will be discussed.
2:00-3:00 p.m.	TIPS FOR PERFORMING AN EFFICIENT OPHTHALMIC WORK-UP <i>Roel Chapa, COT, OSA, OSC</i> In this course, tips and shortcuts to streamline the work-up process will be shared.
3:00-4:00 p.m.	WHAT? I HAVE AN RX CHECK? Sergina Flaherty, COMT, OSC This course will provide participants with many tips and techniques to troubleshoot returning patients with dissatisfaction with their new glasses or prescription. Various scenarios and solutions will be presented.
