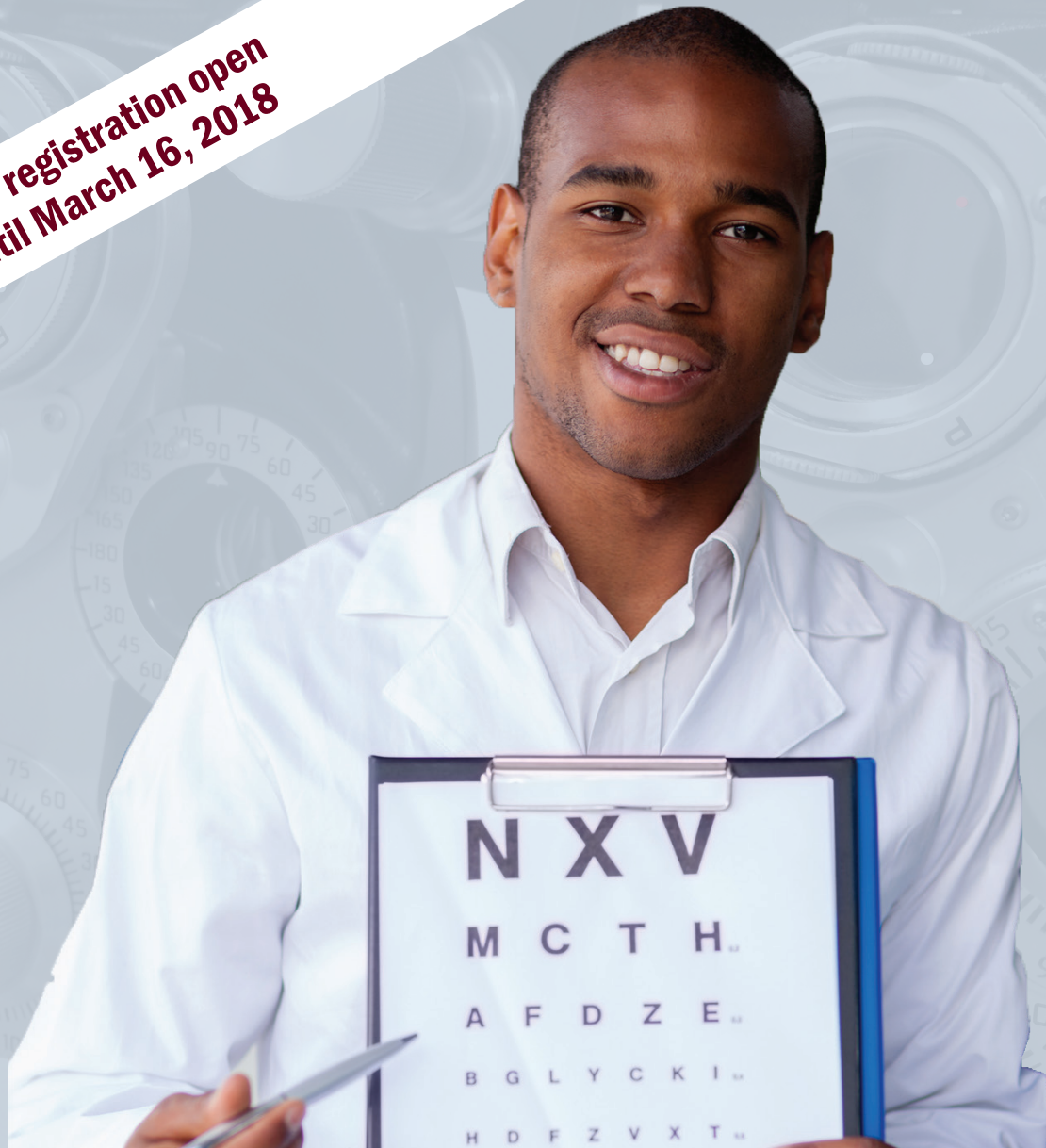

8:00-9:00 a.m.	TODAY'S OCULAR PROSTHETICS <i>Steven Young, BCO, BADO</i> This course will cover the history of artificial eyes. Styles of manufacturing and types of materials used, the process of fitting patients, and proper patient selection and education will be discussed.
9:00-10:00 a.m.	GETTING TO THE ROOT OF THE MATTER: GROWING YOUR OPHTHALMOLOGY VOCABULARY <i>Jacqueline Whinery, COA, OSC, OCS, CCRC</i> This course will explore the Latin and Greek roots of ophthalmology terms and their relationships with other words from the same root, with the goal of improving the technician or scribe's working knowledge of ocular anatomy and medical terminology.

10:15-11:15 a.m.	UNDERSTANDING DIABETIC RETINOPATHY: LEARN TO EXAMINE RETINAL PHOTOGRAPHS AND BECOME AN IMAGING ASSISTANT <i>Lupe Cisneros, COA</i> This course will examine diabetic retinopathy and review common retinal lesions as well as how to interpret retinal photographs so that technicians can become more involved in diabetic eye disease care.
11:15 a.m. -12:15 p.m.	HUMPHREY FIELD ANALYZER BEST PRACTICES <i>Bruce Dean Bailey, COT</i> This course will provide an overview of perimetry and the importance of visual field testing. Instructions to patients, printing, saving test results, and maintenance of the instrument will be emphasized. Solutions to common field testing obstacles will be discussed.

1:00-2:00 p.m.	THE DISPLACED GLOBE <i>Robert Peralta, MD</i> This course will explore orbital pathology.
2:00-3:00 p.m.	THE RETINA AND SYSTEMIC DISEASE <i>Sasha Penn, OD, MBA, FAAO</i> Some systemic diseases such as Diabetes, Hypertension, and Atherosclerosis may have an impact on the retina. This course will review the anatomy and physiology of the retina including findings that may be found with systemic disease. Recognizing these findings is important to ensure patients receive the care they need. Diagnostic imaging and scanning techniques will also be discussed.
3:00-4:00 p.m.	THE DAWN OF OCT-A: IS SODIUM FLUORESCIN ANGIOGRAPHY DEAD? <i>Denice Barsness, CRA, COMT, ROUB, FOPS</i> This course will provide a broad overview of OCT-A technology, including its applications and limitations. Case studies comparing conventional fluorescein angiography with OCT-A will be presented.
