8:00-8:50 a.m.	<b>OCULAR MANIFESTATIONS OF SYSTEMIC DISEASE</b> <i>Peter Donshik, MD</i> The ocular manifestations of systemic diseases can be common and potentially serious or uncommon and innocuous. It is also important of the ophthalmic team to be able to recognize the possible association of an ocular problem with a systemic disease. This course will review the ocular manifestation of diseases involving the vascular system, blood dyscrasias, metabolic, endocrine disorders, and autoimmune diseases.
8:50-9:40 a.m.	<b>ANTI-VEGF TREATMENT FOR DIABETIC RETINOPATHY</b> <i>Katherine Talcott, MD</i> This lecture will discuss the progression of treating diabetic retinopathy from the early days of pan retinal photocoagulation to the modern era of using anti-VEGF to treat retinopathy in the clinic and prior to surgery. Participants will understand the recent studies and outcomes which demonstrate that anti-VEGF is a reasonable treatment option for diabetic retinopathy with and without diabetic macular edema.

9:55-10:45 a.m.	<b>NIX THE NEEDLE: INTRODUCTION TO OCTA</b> <i>Denice Barsness, COMT, ROUB, CDOS, CRA</i> It has been 50 years since sodium fluorescein angiography was developed as a clinical procedure. Fluorescein angiography was the mainstay of retinal diagnostic imaging modalities for decades until the advent of OCT in the mid 1990's. With the emergence of OCTA we may well have a new "king of the hill" for retinal and optic nerve imaging. This course will provide an overview of OCTA technology. Common applications for OCTA will be discussed using case studies. Artifacts and limitations of OCTA will be reviewed and case studies comparing IV sodium fluorescein angiography and OCTA will be utilized.
10:45-11:35 a.m.	<b>PATIENT ADVOCACY</b> <i>Veronica Plessinger, COT</i> This course will cover tips for better assisting patients with their eye care needs. How to obtain prior authorization approvals for medication and ways to increase patient compliance will be discussed.

12:20-1:10 p.m.	<b>EYELID AND FACIAL LESIONS: THE GOOD, THE BAD, AND MODERN TREATMENTS</b> <i>Donald Hudak, MD</i> This course will discuss various eyelid and facial lesions that can be seen in a general ophthalmology and oculofacial surgery practice. Symptoms and signs will be presented, as well as various diagnostic and treatment options. The attendee will be able to recognize benign and malignant features of various lesions.

Both immersion and contact biometry will be discussed.

2:15-3:05 p.m.	<b>SCLERAL LENSES 101: AN OVERVIEW OF THE CURRENT ROLE OF SCLERAL LENSES IN TODAY'S PRACTICE</b> <i>Nicholas Lawrence, OD</i> The intention of this course is to familiarize the attendee with an overview of the technology behind scleral contact lenses. Additionally, we will discuss their expanding role in a variety of visual and medical eye conditions. Lastly, we will discuss the technician's role and the importance of proper insertion and removal training in the long-term success of scleral lens wear.
3:05-3:55 p.m.	<b>COSMETIC CONTACTS: MORE THAN MEETS THE EYE</b> <i>Thomas Steinemann, MD</i> This course will cover the dangers of using cosmetic or decorative contact lenses that are designed to change the iris' appearance or color. There is an increasing demand for the use of these lenses and with that comes in increase in contact lens related complications. The course will also cover the possible complications (including microbial keratitis) and the approaches the FDA is taking to reduce the incidence of complications.

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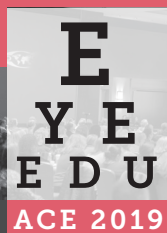
