Annual Continuing Education Program

Held annually each fall in conjunction with the AAO's Annual Meeting, the ACE Program offers in-person and virtual CE courses.

On-Site

The On-Site ACE Program offers three days of lectures as well as a variety of sub-specialty sessions, exam prep courses, and hands-on learning labs. Attendees may select which courses they would like to register for.

On-Demand

The On-Demand ACE Program features online courses that attendees may take at any time within the scheduled access window. Courses are accessible for approximately four weeks. Attendees may select which courses they would like to register for.

Virtual AOP Symposiums
