Certification

IJCAHPO Has Streamlined CE Credit Requirements!

As of August 1, 2020, IJCAHPO only requires Group A credits for certification/recertification. Group B credits earned on or before July 31, 2020 that were also earned within your certification cycle will still be accepted with your next certification/recertification application.

AMA and CMA Category 1 courses for CME will no longer be accepted. IJCAHPO Council organizations that provide Certification, Recertification, and CE credits for its independent certifications shall be recognized for CE credit equivalency for IJCAHPO's recertification requirements. Currently, these organizations include the Ophthalmic Photographers' Society (OPS) and the American Orthoptic Council (AOC). IJCAHPO certificants who are dual certified with IJCAHPO certification and one or more of IJCAHPO's Council organizations will be eligible to submit 1/3 of their recertification credits that come from these Council organizations. The CE course content must meet IJCAHPO's examination content areas or CE credit content categories.

Looking for ways to obtain free CE credits?

- **Teach a class** – Instructors may earn the same amount of credit as those attending the course. Each course may be counted once during a certification cycle.
- **Present a poster** – If you have presented a poster, you may submit it to the IJCAHPO Education Department for credit approval.
- **Write a paper** – If you have authored an article or paper, you may submit it to the IJCAHPO Education Department for credit approval.

Letter from Christine McDonald, COA, COE, OSC, ROUB ***IJCAHPO Secretary of Education***

I am an ophthalmic technician (IJCAHPO certified since 1988), serve on the IJCAHPO Board of Directors as the Secretary of Education, and I am a practice manager, working for a practice with 40 techs who help provide patient care in our clinics. I would like to discuss IJCAHPO's new policies on Group A CE credit as your colleague and as a professional in our continuous learning goals.

There were several factors the IJCAHPO Board of Directors took into consideration when it made the decision to streamline credit options. Revenue was not one of them. By streamlining the A & B credit process, we eliminated the confusion that certificants have about the 2 tracks. We also are making it clearer regarding the educational track of acceptable courses for ophthalmic education, instead of courses, like photoshop, flipped classroom principles, and other courses that do not meet educational criteria for credits.

COMT Performance Test Now Available in a Virtual Format

The computer-simulated COMT Performance Test is now delivered in a virtual format to candidates that are eligible to complete the examination. Eligibility includes successful completion of the COMT multiple-choice examination and the COT Skill Evaluation, if not

completed previously as part of becoming a COT. All candidates need to have access to a computer or laptop with a camera, microphone, and reliable internet. The examination may not be completed on a tablet.
